The film is an unusual fiction documentary that describes the journey of a woman's soul back to herself and spans three continents: Europe, America, and Arabia/Dubai. This documentation, interlaced with many fiction elements, is based on a true story and examines the deep sources of human actions, our society, and the future of our civilization and our planet. It is about man and its soul, women's position in our Western civilized society, the health of our planet, our cultural centers and our global cities. To deal with these issues, the film creates a very unique style, and mixes natural documentary elements with fictional elements in a very suspenseful and fascinating way. The search for the wisest person to ask for advice ends in the realization that the journey is the destination, and that we know everything we need to know, if we can just learn to listen to ourselves without filtering what we hear.

This journey requires us to be tolerant, understand others, and to totally rethink everything we know. Sometimes, we may lose courage, faced with the path our society is currently on. However, we intuitively understand - through the meditative ease of the visual narration and the sensitive sound level - that we will finally become aware of a new vision, a future for humankind, and a future for our planet. We will not lose faith in our civilization. Everything seems to be so tangibly close to each other: The fall and the enlightenment are separated by only a hairbreadth. And it is up to us, to every one of us, and to the choice we make. This is an exceptionally stirring film that opens new horizons, shocks deeply, and eventually reassures in the end.
